

United Way awards \$39,000

BALTIMORE—The Anne Arundel County United Way Partnership Board awarded more than \$39,000 in discretionary funding to local health and human service agencies in or serving residents of Anne Arundel County. These grants, which are provided in addition to those made available through the regional Community Impact awards made earlier this year, were reviewed and voted upon by local Anne Arundel County volunteers.

In June, upon thorough review of each applicant, the Board approved the following:

- Anne Arundel County Court Appointed Special Advocates, Inc. (CASA), Volunteer Center for Anne Arundel County, Annapolis Area Ministries, Food Link Agency Inc., HIV/AIDS Volunteer Enrichment (HAVEN), St. Mary's ESL Program and Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Maryland, \$4,500 each.
- Partners in Care, Hospice of the Chesapeake and the ARC of Anne Arundel County, \$2,661 each.

United Way of Central Maryland is the region's human service leader whose mission is to improve people's lives by mobilizing local communities. It supports programs and initiatives in Baltimore and the five surrounding counties: Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Harford and Howard.
